A Town of Flourishing Folk Culture & Dreams aboard

-Two Historical Narratives of Takaoka Designated as Japan Heritage -

The birth of Takaoka dates back to 1609 (Keicho 14), when Takaoka Castle was founded by Toshinaga Maeda, the second feudal lord of the Kaga Domain. Through a twist of fate, Toshinaga would pass away five years after the establishment of the town and the castle would

eventually be destroyed under the One Castle per Province Law. Toshitsune, the third feudal lord, inherited his older brother's will in reviving and transforming Takaoka into a town of industry and commerce. Famously known as the "Kitchen of Kaga" at the peak of its prosperity, Takaoka boasts a unique culture characterized by craftsmanship(monozukuri) and traditional festivals that continues to be passed down by the townspeople today.

The historical narrative of Takaoka, "Flourishing Folk Culture under the Rule of the Maeda Family of Kaga – People, Craftsmanship, and Heart" is designated as Japan Heritage. In addition, Takaoka appears in the narrative of "Kitamaebune: Ports and Residences Built on the Dreams of Brave Seafarers."

One of the ports of call of Kitamaebune ships, sailing up and down the Sea of Japan as general traders and amassing tremendous wealth, is Fushiki Port in Northern Takaoka City. The affluence and buoyancy brought about by the Kitamaebune translated into magnificent residences and warehouses, Fushiki

Shrine with its festivals, and numerous folk songs in the port town of Fushiki.




